### Description:


Each day, students will complete a carefully guided project designed to develop observational drawing, painting, sculpture and mixed media skills.

This is a wonderful opportunity for young artists to experiment with new materials, refine techniques and build confidence in a supportive, inspiring environment.

All artwork will be completed and taken home at the end of each day.

### Daily Projects:

Monday – Impressionism workshop: Pointillism on Canvas Students will explore colour theory and optical blending while creating a vibrant painting of using pointillist techniques.



Tuesday – Willow Butterfly Sculpture Design and construct a large-scale butterfly form using willow and tissue paper, developing 3D construction skills and structural awareness.



Wednesday – Sculpt & Paint a Clay Spring Chicken Learn hand-building techniques to create a characterful clay sculpture, finished with decorative painted detail.



Thursday – Ink Illustration Workshop: Dragonfly with Coloured Ink Wash Develop fine observational drawing skills using fine liner, exploring line, pattern, symmetry and delicate ink washes.



Friday – Creative Spring Art Journal (Collage & Positivity Pages) A mixed-media journaling workshop combining collage, pattern, lettering and reflective creative exercises to celebrate spring.



### Skills Development:

- Observational Drawing Skills
- Colour mixing and application techniques
- Understanding of artistic styles and processes
- 3D construction and modelling
- Confidence in creative decision-making
- Independent artistic thinking

Hosted by Danielle Reeve – Head of Design and Technology at The Beacon


